Two die in truck, mini bus collision on Chennai-Trichy National Highway

Chennai, April 2 (IANS) Two persons were killed when an omni bus headed for Chennai collided with a truck near Sanjeevi Nagar on Chennai-Trichy national highway on Tuesday morning.

According to police, the omni bus hit the brick-laden truck from behind.

The driver of the bus, M.Chandran (38) from Theni, and a passenger, R.Palaniammal (64), died on the spot.Fourteen people have been injured in the the accident and admitted at the Mahatma Gandhi Memorial Government Hospital. The police have filed a case and investigation is

underway.Details are awaited.

SC grants bail to AAP leader Sanjay Singh New Delhi, April 2 The Supreme IANS) Court on Tuesday granted bail to AAP Rajya Sabha MP Sanjay Singh in the money laundering case linked to the alleged excise policy scam. A three-judge bench of

Justices Sanjiv Khanna, Dipankar Datta and P.B. Varale presided over the case. After hearing the matter at length, the apex court said: "Leave granted. Sanjay Singh is released on bail during pen-

dency of proceedings." The bench noted that the **Enforcement Directorate** (ED) has no objection with Singh being released on bail. However, the bench said that he shall be released on terms and con-ditions to be fixed by the trial court. "Concession shall not be cited as precedent. Sanjay Singh is

entitled to continue with political activities," the top court bench said. It noted: "... we must

record that concession

made on behalf of ED has been made before commencement of arguments. We clarify we have not made any comments on merits." Earlier, the top court had issued notice to the ED and directed tag-ging of the bail plea along with another petition filed by Sanjay Singh challenging his arrest and subsequent remand in the money laundering case.

On Tuesday, the bench dismissed as "infructuous" the aforementioned peti-

tion filed by Singh against ED arrest and remand.

Sanjay Singh had moved the Delhi High Court seeking bail on Jan-uary 4 after Special Judge M.K. Nagpal of Rouse Avenue Court on December 22, 2023 dismissed his Pursuant to the liberty

granted by the Supreme Court in the pending matter, the AAP leader had moved a regular bail application before the jurisdictional trial court.

Woman, son held for murder of priest in UP's Sitapur

Sitapur, April 2 (IANS) A woman and her son were arrested for the murder of a 28-year-old priest of Rameshwar Teerth temple in Uttar Pradesh's Sitapur, said officials.

The woman was identified as Ganga Devi and her son as Sonu. Both were arrested on Monday.

The bloodstained body of the priest, Hi-manshu Mishra was found on the temple pre-mises on March 28.

The arrested ac-cused told the police that the priest had tried to coerce her into a sexual relationship with him, assuring her to solve all her problems.

When he tried to force himself on her, the woman retaliated. SHO, Misrikh, Satyendra Vikram Singh, said that the deceased priest used to entice women into sexual relationships under the guise of resolving their personal tribula-tions. He claimed himself to be a 'tantrik'.

SOG detains 20 trainee SIS from Rajasthan Police Academy Jaipur, April 2 (IANS) Special Operation Group (SOG) of Rajasthan Police on Tuesday detained 20 trainee Sub Inspectors (SIs) at Rajasthan Police Acad-emy (RPA) in connection with the SI 2021 paper leak

emy (RPA) in connection with the SI 2021 paper leak case. The SOG interrogated the accused trainee SIs for three hours at the academy after which they were detained and taken to SOG headquarters for further investigation.

The investigating agency had received information from the previously arrested trainees which revealed that many trainee SIs undergoing training in RPA had made dummy candidates appear in their place during the examination.

The officials said that at least 15 trainee SIs have been arrested in the case.

Earlier, the SOG conducted a dummy examination for all the trainees who had passed the SI Recruitment Examination 2021. They were given the same question paper as the 2021 examination.

Officials said that around 17 trainee SIs could not solve even 20 per cent of the paper while 400 could not solve 50 per cent of the questions.

BJP's Muzaffarpur MP Ajay joins Congress

Patna, April 2 (IANS) BJP MP Ajay Nishad re-signed from the primary membership and all posts of the party on Tuesday and joined the Congress in Delhi.

Ajay Nishad won the Lok Śabha seat on a BJP ticket in 2019. However, this time the party did not give him the ticket from Muzaffarpur, and instead fielded Raj Bhushan Nishad.

In a post on X, Ajay Nishad said: "Respected @JPNadda Ji, shocked by the betrayal of @BJP4India, I resign from all posts and primary membership of the party." Ajay Nishad is likely to contest Muzaffarpur seat as a Congress candidate.

Rajasthan CEO hospitalised

after 'breathing difficulty'

Jaipur, April 2 (IANS) Rajasthan's Chief Electoral Officer Praveen Gupta was admitted to the Sawai Mansingh Hospital (SMS) here on Tuesday after he complained of difficulty in breathing, but discharged

after a few tests. Doctors said that Gup-ta's guards brought him to the hospital and he underwent an ECG, a chest Xray and some routine blood tests. Further treatment will be given after the reports are received.

The senior IAS officer had also fallen ill soon after the Assembly elections in November last year. After he complained of hav-ing trouble breathing and fell unconscious, he was admitted to the ICU and underwent tests.
