UP CEO asks candidates to conduct bank transactions above Rs 10k

Lucknow, March 19 (IANS) Uttar Pradesh Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) Navdeep Rinwa has asked political parties and candidates to conduct transactions exceeding 10,000 rupees through banks.

Parties have been asked to submit a list of star campaigners within a week, with their expenses to be included in the campaign budget. The UP CEO, issued

directives necessitating political parties to seek permission for rallies and processions, including a cap on campaign expenditure at 95 lakh rupees for the Lok Sabha elections and Rs 40 lakh for the Assembly elections, said a release from the office of the CEO.

A cafeteria will also come up in the park.

Larger than life models of King Kong, Godzilla, Dinosaur, Mammoth and other animals are part of this project. These models will be equipped with sensors, and visitors will enjoy the sound effects of their breathing and movement.

Explosive material found near B'luru school

Bengaluru, March 19 (IANS) The police seized explosive material from a vacant land near a private school in Bengalu-

ru on Tuesday. The development has raised concerns in view of the March 1 Bengaluru cafe blast which was carried out by using a low intensity improvised explosive device. According to police, the substances were kept in a tractor parked at an empty site near the school.

SC declines to stay Citizenship Amendment Rules

(IANS) The Supreme Court on Tuesday declined to pass any interim order staying the implementation of the rules notified by the Union Home Ministry under the Citizen-ship Amendment Act (CAA)

Emphasising that the Union government must be given a reasonable time to respond to the interlocutory applications challenging the introduc-tion of 2024 Citizenship Amendment Rules, a Bench headed by Chief Justice of India, DY Chandrachud, posted the mat-ter for further hearing on April 9.

The Bench, also comprising Justices JB Pardiwala and Manoj Misra, refused to pass any direction subjecting grant of citizenship under the impugned law to the outcome of the petitions challenging the validity of CAA.

Solicitor General (SG) Tushar Mehta, appearing for the Centre, pleaded that the impugned law does not take away but grants citizenship and hence, no prejudice must be caused to the petitioners on implementation of the CAA.

Referring to the multiple applications filed seeking stay on implementation of the Citizenship Amendment Rules, SG Mehta added that all these applications had not been served on them and a four-week time may be allowed for filing of reply.

On the other hand, Senior Advocate Kapil Sibal, appearing on behalf of the petitioners, strongly pressed for a stay on implementation of the Citi-

Amendment Rules.

"The problem is if somebody gets citizen-ship, it will be irreversible to reverse it and these petitions (challenging CAA) will get infructuous," Sibal argued.

He reiterated that the top court in 2019 did not

pass any stay order on implementation of the CAA because of non-existence of the rules. Last week, the top court had agreed to urgently list the pleas seek-

ing a stay on implementa-

tion of the Citizenship

Amendment Rules. In its application, Indian Union Muslim League (IUML) stated the rules notified under CAA are manifestly arbitrary and created an unfair advantage in favour of a class of persons on the ground

solely of their religious identity, which is impermissible under Articles 14 and 15 of the Constitution. It added that around

250 petitions challenging the provisions of the CAA are pending before the Supreme Court and in case CAA is held to be unconstitutional, an "anomalous situation" "anomalous situation" would arise when people who would have got citizenship under the impugned Act and Rules would have to be stripped of their citizenship.

Therefore, it is in the best interest of every person to defer the implementation of CAA and impugned rules till this Hon'ble Court finally decides the matter...The Petitioner had pressed for a stay of the implementation of the provisions of the impugned Act.

Ahmedabad-Mumbai bullet train to be launched in 2026: Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw

New Delhi, March 19 (IANS) Railway Minister Àshwińi Vaishnaw said on Tuesday that the Ahmedabad- Mumbai bullet train will be launched in 2026.

"India's first bullet train will be ready in 2026, and will run in one section from Surat," the minister said.

He said significant progress has been made in the construction of various stations and work has begun on the sea tunnel through which the train will reach Mumbai from Thane.

The Railway Minister had earlier shared a video of the Mumbai-Ahmedabad 'Bullet train' corridor

which will cut the travel time on the 508 km route between the two cities to a mere 2 hours. 'Stay tuned for #Bul-

letTrain in Modi 3.0!," the minister had posted on X. The video highlights

some of the features of the state-of-the-art train project being built with an investment of Rs 1.08 lakh crore. These include: The Bullet train is expected to touch a maximum speed of 320 kilometres per hour on the route. The corridor will feature a slab track system, a technology to be used for the first time in India. As many as 24 river bridges, 28 steel bridges,

and seven mountain tunnels are being erected for the Bullet train route. The corridor will also have a 7 km undersea tunnel. The video described the project as "a marvel of world-class engineering" and the "future of India.

The objective of the project is to develop a high-frequency mass transportation system by constructing the High-Speed Rail between Mumbai and Ahmedabad, using Japan's Shinkansen technology (also known as the Bullet Train), thereby enhancing mobility in India and contributing to regional economic development.

"Leaders of INDIA alli-ance are intentionally in-sulting Hinduism and their statements are also wellplanned and thought of. Congress and DMK, in particular don't hesitate in denigrating Hinduism with their profane remarks, as they are not so generous for other beliefs and religions," said PM Modi at the rally, attended by thousands of supporters. PM Modi further lashed out at the INDIA

bloc for their opposition and condemnation of 'Shakti', while describing the latter as 'women power and mother power'. The controversy on Shakti ignited after Rahul Gandhi's controversial remarks during display of Opposition strength at Mumbai's Shivaji Park on

Our holy textbooks are witness to it," the PM thundered at the rally.
