Northern Railways slash fare in Kashmir Valley by 50 pc

Srinagar, March 20 (IANS) As a major relief to commuters, Northern Railways on Wednesday decided to reduce the train fare in the Kashmir Valley. "Railways have reinstated second class ordinary fare on passenger trains in the Valley," the officials said.

The charges have dropped from 40 to 50 per cent. Before the re-lief, the fare was Rs 35 from Sadura station (Anantnag district) to Srinagar. It has now come down to Rs 15.

"This relief is applicable across the Valley in Kashmir and travelling by train has become highly affordable and cheap after the relief." officials said.

Addressing the Startup Mahakumbh at the Bharat Mandapam here, the Prime Minister said, "India will have the upper hand in AI and we will not let the opportunity go." He exhorted the young startup founders to find solutions that will not only help India solve its problems and achieve the goal of Viksit Bharat but also create a better future

for the world. PM Modi

said tried and trusted innovations that were successful in India with its diverse geography would work anywhere in the world. He said that India had now become the third largest startup ecosystem in the world, and the gov-ernment had for the first time introduced the chapter of Startups as an Engine of Growth in the G-20 agenda this year bringing the country's innovative talent on the world map. PM Modi pointed out that India's startup ecosystem had come a long way since he first launched the Startup India and Stand up India movements at a small gathering in Vigyan Bhavan attended by a few

experts. "Today the ecosystem has grown with over 1.25 lakh registered startups in the country and with which over 12 lakh youngsters are linked. Bharadwaj had also directed immediate action against the Principal and Head of Department (HoD) for their reprehensible act of pressuring students to withdraw their complaint.

New Delhi, March 20 (IANS) The Congress has approached the Delhi High Court challenging the reassessment proceedings initiated against it by tax authorities.

A Bench of Acting Chief Justice Manmohan and Justice Manmeet PS Arora on Wednesday scheduled the matter for an expedited hearing on Thursday.

The counsel representing the Congress stressed the urgency of the situation, stating that the Income Tax authorities have decided to re-open the assessment for the last four years. He said three such pe-

titions pertaining to three different years are already listed for hearing during the day.

This development comes on the heels of the Congress facing a substantial tax demand, exceeding Rs 100 crore for the assessment year 2018-19, wherein the party's income was assessed to be over Rs 199 crore.

The Bench allowed the request saying, "Okay if in order by 12:30 pm, it will

be listed tomorrow. The move comes after the Delhi HC, last week, upheld the Income Tax Appellate Tribunal's (ITAT) order dated March 8 rejecting the Congress' plea

It had, however, granted liberty to the Congress to move the ITAT afresh in

case of any change of circumstances.

The Bench had expressed dissatisfaction with the handling of the matter by the party saving matter by the party, saying that it seemed someone at its office had been negligent since 2021.

Dinhata Trinamool-BJP clash: FIR registered against Union Minister

Kolkata, March 20 (IANS) An FIR has been registered against Union Minister of State for Home Affairs Nisith Pramanik and 44 BJP supporters over the clashes with the Trinamool Congress workers at Dinhata in West Bengal's Cooch Behar district. The FIR was registered by the state Minister for north Bengal development and ruling party MLA from Dinhata, Udayan Guha. During the clashes on Tuesday night, in which the local sub-division police officer Dhiman Mitra sustained injuries, Pramanik and Guha were seen dashing towards each other. Meanwhile, Governor C.V. Ananda Bose started for Dinhata from Kolkata to take an on the spot review of the situation. Earlier in the day, the Governor sought a detailed report from the newly-appointed Director General of Police, Sanjoy Mukherjee on the clash. An air of tension continued to prevail in pockets of Dinhata. Although the Trinamool Congress convened a 24hour bandh at Dinhata on Wednesday, it was called off later in the day. "Let the Governor come to Dinhata and take stock of the situation. If he gets a single proof of my direct involvement in the matter, I will resign as a member of the state cabinet," Udayan Guha told the media.
