# No interim relief for Arvind Kejriwal from Delhi HC, next hearing on April 3

New Delhi : The Delhi high court on Wednesday did not allow any interim relief to Delhi chief minister Arvind Kejriwal who is in the custody of the Enforcement Directorate as the high court only issued notices regarding Kejriwal's plea and posted the matter for further hearing on April 3. A bench of Justice State Market State tice Swarana Kanta Sharma issued a notice to the ED on Arvind Kejriwal's plea seeking immediate release and declaring his arrest and remand as illegal and asked the agency to reply within April 2.

Thé high court rejected the contention of sénior advocate AM Singhvi who appeared for Kejriwal and argued that no reply from ED was required. The court said it is duty-bound to hear both sides fairly. to hear both sides fairly keeping in mind the principles of natural justice and hence ED's reply is



essential and crucial to decide the present case.

"Thus, having regard to the nature of issues raised in this petition, this Court is of the opinion that the respondent has to be granted an opportunity to file a reply, as an opportu-nity for effective represen-tation, and declining this opportunity would amount to denial of fair hearing as well as violation of one of the principles of natural justice i.e., audi- alteram partem, which is applicable to both the parties and not one," the court said. Meanwhile, the ED is

likely to produce Kejriwal in a court on Thursday as his present remand will conclude tomorrow. The ED arrested Kejriwal last Thursday in connection with the Delhi liquor probe and sought a six-day custody starting from March 22. ED may seek an extension of Kejriwal's custodial remand or seek court directions for send-

Hopes were pinned on high court's order today as Kejriwal urged the court to order his immediate release from ED custody as his arrest on the cusp of elections was against the basic structure of the Constitution, "My prayer is re-lease me now," Kejriwal's counsel Singhvi told the court. Additional Solicitor General S V Raju, appearing for the agency, said the "bulky" petition was served upon them only on Tuesday, and three weeks' time should be given to bring their stand on record. For interim relief as well, appropriate time should be given to respond, he said.

### Scare at Kolkata airport as collision between IndiGo, Air India Express aircraft narrowly averted

New Delhi, March 27 (IANS) An IndiGo aircraft narrowly avoided a collision with an Air India Express aircraft at the runway of Kolkata's Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose International Airport airport on Wednesday, sending shivers down the spines of 169 passengers aboard the latter plane. According to reports, the IndiGo aircraft was awaiting clearance to enter the runway when craft was awaiting clearance to enter the runway when it inadvertently brushed the wingtip of the Air India Express plane at around 10:30 a.m. The close call sparked immediate alarm, prompting the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) to initiate a comprehensive investigation into the matter.

"A minor graze between a taxiing IndiGo aircraft and that of another carrier was reported from Kolkata Airport. The aircraft returned to the bay for inspection and necessary action, as per protocol. Consequently, Indi-Go flight 6E 6152 between Kolkata and Darbhanga has been delayed," an IndiGo spokesperson said.

"Refreshments were provided to all passengers and an alternate aircraft has been arranged to minimise delay and inconvenience to the passengers. IndiGo prioritises passenger safety above all else. An incident report will be submitted to DGCA in due course, as per protocol," the spokesperson added. Meanwhile, the Air India Express (AIX) spokesperson, in a statement, said that the wingtip of a taxiing aircraft of another airline grazed one of their aircraft, which was stationary and awaiting clearance to enter the runway at Kolkata for a scheduled operation to Chennai.

## Eknath Shinde, Ajit Pawar, Ashok Chavan among BJP's 40 star campaigners for Maharashtra

Mumbai, March 27 (IANS) The BJP on Wednésday announced the list of 40 star campaigners for Maharashtra where the party, along with MahaYuti allies, has set an ambitious target of 45 plus of the total 48 Lok Sabha seats in the state.

Interestingly, the BJP has included names of

has included names of Chief Minister Eknath Shinde, Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar and union minister of state Ramdas Athavale indicating that the party treats allies on par to achieve its ambitious target in Maharashtra and at the national level of 400 plus seats. Similarly, former Chief Minister and veteran Congress leader Ashok Chavan, who is now Rajya Sabha member after joining the BJP, figured in the list.BJP insiders said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi is expected to address about 25 rallies during five phases of election.
The list of star campaigners was announced a day before the MahaYuti plans to announce seat sharing agreement (on Thursday).The list of star campaigners include PM Modi, Defence Minister Aginath Singh, Union

### **Delhi Assembly adjourned till Monday following protest**

New Delhi, March 27 (IANS) Proceedings were abruptly adjourned in Delhi Assembly till Monday following uproar from Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) legislators over the arrest of Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal by ED in the excise policy case.

Sources said that the Assembly session will prioritise Chief Minister Kejriwal's second directive, issued from ED's custody, which calls for the provision of free medication and diagnostic tests at government-operated Mohalla clinics.

Prior to the assembly's session, AAP MLAs had gathered outside the premises, chanting slogans de-

manding Kejriwal's immediate release.

Wearing yellow T-shirts with "Mei bhi Kejriwal" written on the backside, the AAP MLAs, including Ministers Atishi and Saurabh Bharadwaj, raised slogans against the arrest of Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal by the Enforcement Directorate (ED) in the excise policy

"Our MLAs are united in their protest against the unjust detention of Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal. There's a concerning trend to undermine democracy in our nation, evident in the targeting and incarceration of opposition figures," said Minister Atishi. Even as the AAP MLAs were protesting, BJP MLAs

also raised slogans outside Delhi Vidhan Sabha demanding Chief Minister's resignation.

Shortly after receiving instructions from Chief Minister Kejriwal to address the medicine shortage, Health Minister Saurabh Bharadwaj announced that a session of the Delhi Assembly would convene on Wednesday.

# Ex-MP Sanjay Nirupam skins Congress for 'total surrender' to Shiv Sena (UBT); may rebel

Mumbai, March 27 (IANS) Veteran Congress leader and ex-MP Sanjay Nirupam on Wednesday whiplashed his own party leadership, alleging an abject 'surrender' to the Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) ally, Shiv Sena (UBT), headed by former Chief Minister Uddhav Thacker ay. Nirupam (59) launched a broadside at the Congress and SS (UBT) after the latter announced its list of 16 Lok Sabha candidates, including the Mumbai North West seat which

he (Nirupam) had coveted.
The SS (UBT) has
fielded Amol G. Kirtikar -an accused in the infamous 'khichdi scam' of the BrihanMumbai Municipal Corporation and the son of rival Shiv Sena MP Gajan an Kirtikar -- as its candidate for Mumbai North West, taking the MVA allies Congress and the Nationalist Congress Party

(SP) by surprise.
"I will not support such a 'khichdi chor' (thief) can-

didate... He has been unilaterally thrust upon Congress by the SS (UBT). We hope the (Congress) - which adopts a 'high

moral ground' vis-a-vis corruption -- lodges its strong protest with Thackeray for the tainted nominee (Amol Kirtikar)," Nirunam soid pam said. Launching a veiled attack at Congress Presi-

dent Mallikarjun Kharge, state Congress chief Nana Patole, and the party's Mumbai head Varsha Gaikwad – without taking names - Nirupam said the party has abandoned its lakh's of activists all over the city, state and the

country.
"The leadership does seem to be bothered about its workers... The Congress talks of 'Nyay' (justice) to various sections of society, but injustice is being meted out to its own workers. Enough is enough...no more. Now it will be a decisive move for me," Nirupam said.

Turning to the SS (UBT), the former threeterm MP said that by announcing Amol Kirtikar's name for Mumbai North West, Thackeray has thrown a challenge at the Congress, which failed to carry out tough negotiations in the seat-charing

"The SS (UBT) is not as powerful as perceived... It cannot win a single seat in Maharashtra without Congress' support. Yet, it has pressurised us and that is highly condemnable. But the Congress did not retaliate though seats were snatched away by SS (UBT). Our leadership even failed to save Mumbai, Sangli, and other seats," said Nirupam.

He alleged that the

move by Thackeray indicates 'a hidden agenda' to finish off the Congress in the state and bury it in Mumbai – both places where it held sway for decades in the past.

#### Former wrestler held in Delhi for **smuggling Malana** cream from Himachal

New Delhi, March 27 (IANS) A former wrestler was arrested along with his aide for smuggling 'Malana Cream' from Malana in Himachal Pradesh and selling the same in Delhi-NCR and other parts of the country, the police said on Wednesday. The accused wrestler has been identified as Hanumante (30), a resident of Civil Lines, while his associate has been identified as Adnan Ahmed (32), a resident of Jamia Nagar. The police also recovered 350 gm charas, valued at over Rs 10 lakh, from the possession of the accused, which was being transported in a Mercedes car. Additional Commissioner of Police (Crime Branch), Sanjay Bhatia, said that recently, the police received specific inputs that drug traffickers are procuring 'charas' from Malana and Kullu in Himachal Pradesh and selling

# Kolkata, March 27 (IANS) Dum Dum Lok Sabha constituency in North 24 Parganas Dis-

trict, which has a history of changing its voting pattern in consecutive elections since 1977, will be an interesting watch this time, with three veteran politicians clashing with each other. For Trinamool Congress' three-time MP since

2009 from Dum Dum, Saugata Roy, the concern is his winning margin in 2019 which came down sharply to 52,999 from 1,54,934 in 2014.

The second factor that might be cause of concern for Saugata Roy is that the CPI(M) this time has fielded party veteran and central committee member, Dr Sujan Chakraborty, from Dum Dum, where his party still has a dedicated voter base.

In case Dr Sujan Chakraborty, with his vast

experience in party organisation activities as well as electoral politics, is able to grab a substantial share of the anti-BJP votes from Dum Dum, it could be rough going for Saugata

In West Bengal's Dum Dum it is a clash

between three salt and pepper politicians

Roy.
At the same time, the BJP has fielded Shilb-hadra Dutta, who as an erstwhile Trinamool Congress leader from North 24 Parganas District has substantial experience in handling the ruling party's organisational affairs there.

Shilbhadra Dutta joined the BJP before the 2021 West Bengal Assembly polls and also contested unsuccessfully as the party's candidate from Barrackpore Assembly

constituency that year.

However, he was one of the few who did not rejoin the Trinamool Congress even of the height gress even after being defeated, which substantially enhanced his political credibility.

The factor that might make Dum Dum anybody's game is the change in the voting pattern since 1977.In 1977 it was the Janata Party's Ashok Krishna Dutta who won from that constituency, but only for a single term.

In 1980, the CPI(M)'s Niren Ghosh emerged as the victor from Dum Dum. However the equation changed again in 1984, when the Congress' Asumble has get cleated from tosh Laha got elected from the constituency. Thereafter,

CPI(M)'s Nirmal Kanti Chatterjee got elected from Dum Dum for three consecutive terms in 1989, 1991 and 1996.

In 1998 BJP's Tapan Sikdar emerged as the surprise winner from Dum Dum and he got re-elect-ed from the same constituency again in 1999. Again in 2004, Sikdar got defeated by CPI(M)'s Amitava Nandy.

The case is already being probed by the Serious Fraud Investigation Office (SFIO). The Kochi office of the ED has filed an ECIR in the case. The ECIR is similar to the FIR lodged by the police for cognizable offences. This issue was first raised last year by Congress MLA Mathew Kuzhalnadan on the basis

of a media report, which

that "CM Vijayan's daughter Veena Vijayan's IT firm Exalogic had received Rs 1.72 crore from the mining company CMRL, in which the KSIDC has around 13 per cent stake". Initially, CM Vijayan and the CPI(M) defended the case both indefended the case both inside and outside the Assembly. They said that this was nothing but a political witch hunt. But the defence fell apart when the SFIO took up the probe last month. The SFIO has completed one round of probe by visiting the offices of CMRL and KSIDC and has taken statements from officials of both these firms.
